Krauss-Maffei Wegmann assurance to be compliant with the Oslo convention

Krauss-Maffei Wegmann assurance to be compliant with the Oslo convention
Krauss-Maffei Wegmann GmbH & Co. KG (KMW) hereby reconfirms it does not infringe the clauses of the 2008 Oslo Convention on Cluster Munitions. KMW has never produced Cluster Munitions nor does it intend to do so in the future. Being a leading land system integrator, KMW is, and was involved in the development and manufacturing of various defence systems. This included the license production of the MLRS/MARS rocket artillery system.

As many other systems the MLRS/MARS system is theoretically capable of firing various types of artillery munitions, including bomblets, which are banned by the Convention on Cluster Munitions. However, MLRS/MARS was not specifically manufactured for firing Cluster Munitions. There is no doubt that the manufacture of MLRS/MARS is fully in line with all laws and conventions. In addition all sales of MLRS/MARS have been approved by the German export authorities according to the respective regulations. KMW sold the MARS-System only to customers, who joined the Oslo convention.
