

Fact sheet Siemens in the UK

Facts and figures in fiscal 2007 (Sept. 30, 2007) in continuing operations*

- Siemens has been operating in the UK for 164 years and holds a leading position in the country's energy, industry and healthcare sectors. Siemens IT Solutions and Services and Siemens Financial Services are active in all three sectors.
- Sales to customers in the UK: ~€4 billion
- New orders: ~€5.5 billion
- Employees: ~18,400 employees in the UK
- R&D expenses: ~€101 million
- Regional Footprint: operates from over 100 locations throughout the UK.
*Discontinued operations consist of SV activities as well as carrier networks, enterprise networks and mobile devices activities.

History and corporate citizenship

- Siemens began operations in the UK in 1843. The company's early successes included the laying of the first undersea cable between Great Britain and the United States, the installation of the first electric street lighting system, the development of the first water meter and the construction of the first public railway.
- Siemens in the UK provides essential services across key sectors of the UK economy, including maintaining fleets of electric and diesel trains, asset funding for medical equipment in the NHS, and running back-end processes for major financial institutions and public sector bodies.
- Siemens believes it has a responsibility to make a positive impact on the communities in which it is active. As a major employer in the UK and as a company that can contribute solutions for mastering climate change, Siemens took the initiative in 2007 and invited a group of the UK's leading thinkers to Westminster to discuss whose job it is to save the planet.

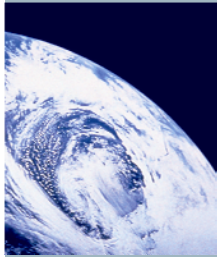
Energy

- Siemens is one of the world leaders in offshore wind turbines and is the leading supplier of wind turbines in the UK, with 636 installed and over 400 more on order.
- We provide 40% of the UK's wind turbine generating capacity.
- The Siemens Masterdrive range of variable speed drives installed in Drax Power station, near Selby in North Yorkshire (Europe's largest coal fired power station) will deliver a reduction in carbon emissions of 5%, the equivalent of taking 275,000 cars off the road.
- More than a third of the UK's mainland electricity supply is generated using our equipment.
- We read meters for nearly 10 million homes and businesses in the UK.

Industry (including Water, Mobility, Lighting and Buildings)

- 200,000 of our domestic appliances are sold in the UK each year.
- 50% of cars in the UK are fitted with our lamps.
- Washing your dishes in a Siemens eco-friendly appliance uses on average 9 litres compared to 63 litres if washed by hand. Retailers Tesco and ASDA have installed Siemens building management systems across the country. These help to improve the energy performance of stores systems, such as air conditioning by ensuring they are only used when required.





- The intelligent lighting systems at Siemens new UK head office delivers an estimated saving of 122 tonnes of CO2 and £34,000
- We manufacture and maintain more of the UK's road traffic infrastructure than any other company.
- More than a million people cross the road safely every day thanks to our technology.
- We manufacture and maintain the Heathrow Express trains, which carry 17,000 passengers between London Paddington station and Heathrow Airport every day.
- Our traffic management systems ease congestion in towns and cities, giving drivers advance warning of traffic hotspots and directions to car park spaces.

Healthcare

- Our medical equipment is used to screen 15,000 women in the UK for breast cancer every week day of the year.
- Superconducting magnets made by Siemens in Oxfordshire are at the heart of more than a third of all MRI body scanners installed in hospitals worldwide.
- Siemens is the largest supplier of hearing aids and audiological equipment to the NHS
- Siemens is the only company to offer one-stop solutions from prevention, diagnostics and therapy to post-intervention care.

IT Solutions & Services

- We process 6 million new UK passports each year.
- We keep nearly a fifth of all cash machines in the UK in good working order.

Finance

- Siemens provides financial services to 90% of the FTSE100.

Technology partner for a new urban district

- UK property developer Quintain Estates and Developments is regenerating more than 70 acres of land in Wembley in a bid to create a world-class residential, retail and leisure experience.
- Siemens is acting as strategic partner to Quintain by advising Quintain on the most appropriate technology solutions across the Wembley redevelopment and then helping to provide and implement those solutions, preferably through its own products and services.
- The scope of the partnership agreement (signed at the end of June 2007) could cover building management systems, fire detection, power generation, telecommunications, eco-friendly domestic appliances, building and overall site security, and traffic controls.
- The development is still underway, but some of the key technology decisions are already being made. With sustainability crucial to the project, locally generated electricity and heating is planned to reduce the development's carbon footprint. Also, the latest building technology will be used to minimise energy consumption. In addition, it is envisaged that fibre-optic will bring super-fast voice and data communications to the area.
